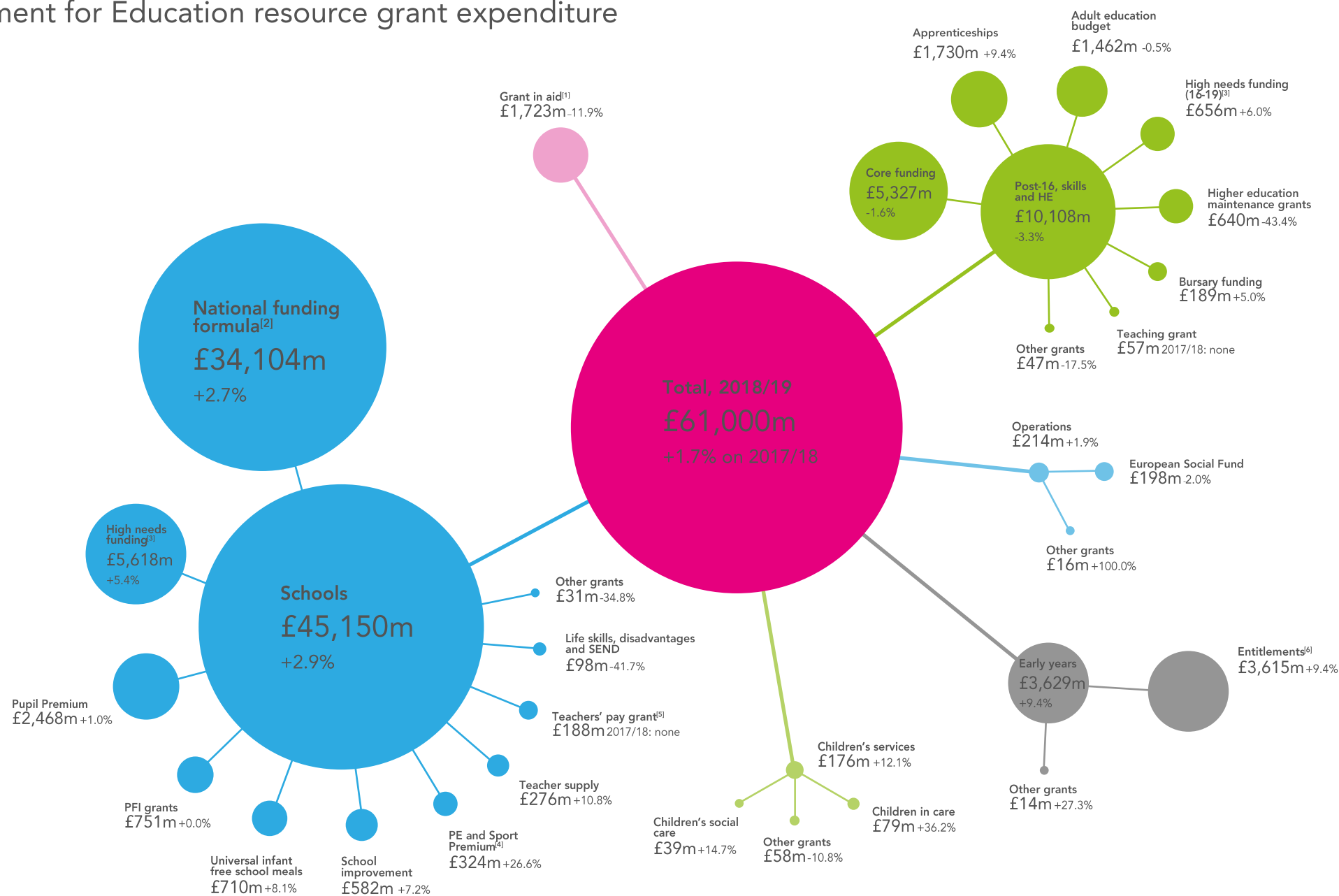


# Education spending in 2018/19

## Department for Education resource grant expenditure

Figures are those reported for the Department for Education and its executive agencies (the Education and Skills Funding Agency, the Teaching Regulation Agency and the Standards and Testing Agency). Figures do not cover other DfE group bodies that are consolidated into the DfE accounts. Percentage changes are not adjusted for inflation.

Grant expenditure is that spent on programmes by the DfE and its executive agencies, plus funding to the DfE's non-departmental public bodies. It does not cover staff costs and other operating costs of the DfE and its executive agencies, nor non-cash expenditure. Resource grant expenditure covers day-to-day programme costs as opposed to capital expenditure, which is not shown here. In 2017/18 £246m of resource grant expenditure was also incurred on the Education Services Grant—not shown here, as there was no spending in 2018/19.

[1] Funding provided to the DfE's 11 non-departmental public bodies, plus Aggregator Vehicle PLC and the Office of the Schools Adjudicator. [2] Principal stream of schools funding, based on school and pupil characteristics. [3] Additional funding of provision for those with special educational needs and disabilities, and for alternative provision up to the age of 16. [4] Paid to primary schools to boost physical activity. [5] Part-funding for teacher pay rises. [6] Funding of free early years education for two-, three- and four-year-olds.
