

Addendum to “Measuring pupil mobility in secondary schools in England”

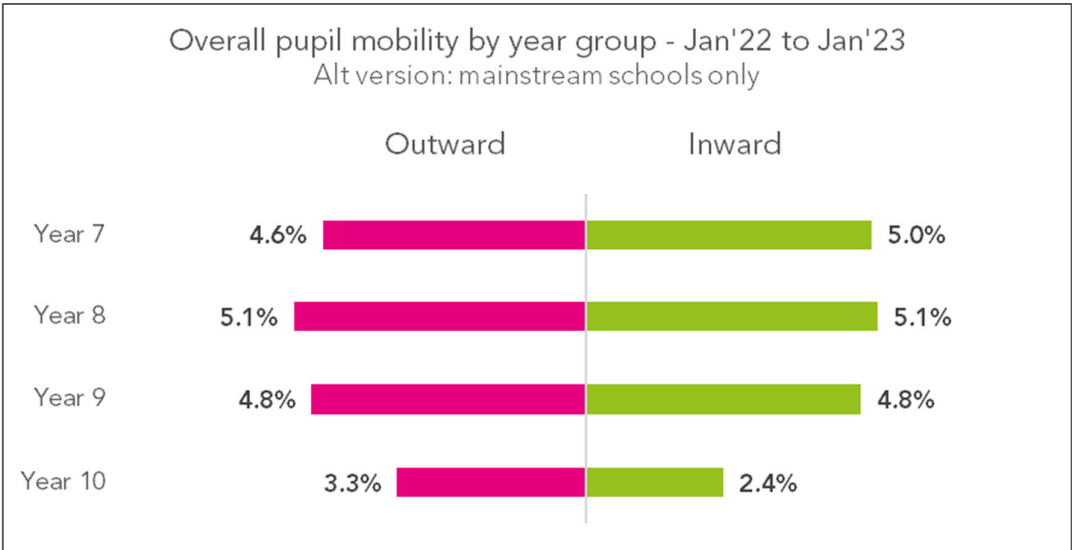

Figure 3-2 alt: inward and outward pupil mobility by school governance, mainstream schools

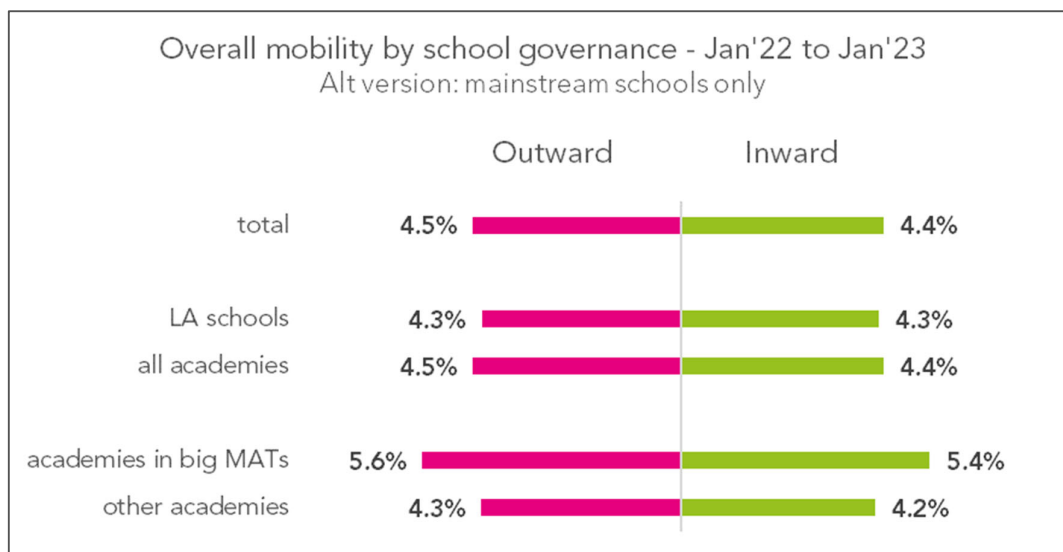
